City of Grayling Right-of-Way Permit Requirements and Information

The processing of Right-of-Way permits for the City of Grayling is outlined below:

- 1. Applicant must submit a permit application to the City of Grayling Manager.
- 2. Manager will review and submit permit to the City of Grayling Department of Public Works for review.
- 3. City Manager and Department of Public Works will review, sign, and return permit.
- 4. Preconstruction meeting will be held, if needed.
- 5. Construction.
- 6. After construction is complete, Applicant will contact City Manager to schedule a post construction inspection.
- b. Applicant must submit post construction photos with proof of restoration, within 1 week of completion.
- 7. Required restoration includes:
- a. Removing ALL Miss Dig flags.
- b. Topsoil and seed all disturbed grassy areas.
- c. Replace and restore all disturbed landscaping, including any impacted irrigation.
- d. Replace all removed concrete, HMA, or brick that was removed for construction.
- e. Any other necessary measures to restore the area to its preconstruction state.
- 8. Surety Bond will be released 7 days after post construction inspection.
